Possible Projects

Long Term In Depth Video Project

Due on last day of semester.
Instructor must approve subject.
Maximum of three per group.
Should be of sufficient length and demonstrate technical competence for your level in television production.

Groups will be created and projects assigned with consideration to Long Term or other projects.

CNN

3-8 minutes project based on CNN Newsource stories.

Must have local hook.

Must have original supportive material.

Public Service Project

Pick an organization to produce a program or series of spots highlighting their activities.

Group size should be consistent with difficulty and length of produced programs.

Some projects are required. Others are suggested as possibilities. If you have a project that you would like to substitute discuss your idea with the instructor. All projects must be for airplay. There will be no purely personnel projects allowed.

Your final grade will be based on the quality of your productions. During the semester there will be additional opportunities for you to develop your production skills. Due to the nature of the course, midterm grades are only indications of your current standing. Your final grade will be determined by a review of your projects on the final day of class.
