

Outside Events

All staff members are required to earn 60 outside event shooting points this semester. Event location, difficulty and editing requirements determine point value of event. These events offer you a unique opportunity to be involved in school activities and present them for the entire community to enjoy. You are to approach these with the same degree of dedication as you are expected to approach your personal projects.

A monthly list will be posted with the appropriate number of sign-up places. Print your full name in available slots only. Once you have signed up for an event only Mr. Pinelli can remove it. The times listed are the published starting times of the events? Occasionally these starting times change. You are responsible for checking on the day of the event for the actual starting time. Once you sign up for an event you must find someone to replace you if you must withdraw.

You are responsible for the set up of the equipment and/or being there at least ½ hour before starting time. For sporting events you must check with Ms. Holecek for set up and game time. The beginning of school the following day must return the equipment to the studio.

Make sure that there are approximately two (2) minutes of rolling tape before the event begins. All events should be completely edited within five school days. Any event not edited within this limit may receive less than the possible points. Failure to tape an event will result in an equal number of negative points. All taping participants are responsible for the set up, taping, striking of equipment, and editing of the event. Deduction of points for below acceptable levels of quality in taping or editing will be considered.

If you have any questions regarding the filming of an event make sure to see Mr. Pinelli and discuss your concerns.

Evaluation:

All students are expected to earn 60 points
Less than 60 points = one drop in final grade
